- 6. Pay Application fee of \$100 (Non-refundable).

#### **Application Fee**

The Application Fee is \$100. This is a non-refundable fee.

#### **Acceptance Fee**

If your application is successful and you are offered a place in St Martin's College, you will be required to pay the following fee **before 4pm Friday 5th February 2021** to confirm your accommodation:

Orientation Week Rent \$250

#### The following fees are also payable:

Refundable Deposit \$200 Paid at commencement of residency and available for refund upon exit from the

College. See Handbook for conditions on refund of deposit.

CSU IT Network Fee \$288 Invoiced \$144 per session for Sessions 1 and 2. Fee subject to change by CSU.

#### **Accommodation Fees**

#### \$6660 per year for 36 weeks of accommodation (\$185/wk)

You may stay in your room and / or leave all your personal items in your room during the three university breaks. At the end of the academic year you must vacate your room by 9.00am on Monday one week after session 2 exams end. Any additional nights you may require must be requested in writing and will be charged at the Casual Accommodation rate of \$60 per night. Additional nights of accommodation requested are not guaranteed. Accommodation over Summer session is available at a reduced rental and by agreement with the Head of College. There may be work or study reasons why additional accommodation over this session is required.

Please note that Invoices are issued four times per year. An accommodation invoice will be sent out prior to the start of each term and **payment is due at the end of the first week of each term**. Fees may be subject to change at any time. Invoices are based on the number of weeks in each of four terms so the amount will vary from term to term.

- Accommodation offers are made to most students following the successful completion of an interview with the Head of College.
- St Martin's College practices an inclusive selection process and does not discriminate on the basis of race, religion or sexuality.
- Offers are made on the basis of the order applications are received until all vacancies are filled.
   After that time applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
